Position Description

TITLE: Assistant Coach

PRIMARY FUNCTION: The primary goal of a coach ultimately is to provide a positive learning environment so the players return to play football the following year through their freshman year in high school.

SCOPE OF RESPONSIBILITY:

- Coaches are expected to adhere to the regulations and policies of the West Wauwatosa Youth Football Club and the AAFYL
- All coaches signed up by the beginning of March shall become members of the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association (membership fee paid by club)
- Coaches may attend the annual three-day WFCFA clinic in Madison which is usually the end of March-beginning of April. The club pays for the cost of the clinic, lodging (two per room), and meals. Coaches attending the clinic with the club picking up the tab for lodging and meals are expected to attend each day's activities.
- Coaches MUST be able to work with young children and keep things "fun"
- Coaches MUST teach the kids proper and safe football techniques
- Coaches MUST understand the club's attendance and playing time policies and follow them
- Coaches MUST understand that the execution of plays during games is riddled with mistakes
- Attends all meetings as assigned by the VP-Football Operations or Head Coach as well as practices and games
- Use sound and acceptable coaching practices
- Run well-organized practice sessions
- Set an example of positive attitude and teamwork
- Assist team manager and head coach in any non-coaching matters as needed
- Be thoroughly prepared to meet your coaching responsibilities for skill instruction and supervisory duties
- Resolve any differences of opinion with other coaches/parents away from the earshot of the players
- Ability to communicate with other coaches/referees/parents in a non-confrontational manner

EDUCATION / KNOWLEDGE / SKILLS:

Must have extensive knowledge of football
Must enjoy working with children of all ages
Must be able to communicate with young players in a positive manner

PERFORMANCE MEASURES:

To carry out the aims and objectives of the Cyclones program as outlined by the club's Board of Directors. To instruct athletes in individual and team fundamentals, strategy, and physical training necessary for them to realize a degree of individual and team success.
