Position Description

TITLE: Head Coach

PRIMARY FUNCTION: The primary goal of a coach ultimately is to provide a positive learning environment so the players return to play football the following year through their freshman year in high school.

SCOPE OF RESPONSIBILITY:

- All the responsibilities of an assistant coach
- Consult with coaches from Wauwatosa West High School about
 - Drills, etc. for youth players
 - Play naming conventions
 - Use of school equipment
- Run pre-season coach's meetings for your team to assign responsibilities and coordinate the multiple facets of game (blocking schemes on plays, defensive alignments and responsibilities, etc.)
- Attend the annual "Rules" league meeting just prior to the start of the practice schedule
- Highly organized to plan in advance the running up to four practices a week
 - Weekly practice schedule due to VP-Football Operations before that week's first practice
 - Delegate responsibility to assistant coaches as needed
 - Teaching football in simple terms, starting with basics and moving slowly upward
- Self confidence and positive approach to handling a plethora of possible issues with
 - Assistant coaches
 - Parents
 - Referees
 - Visiting teams
 - Team manager
 - WWYFC Board of Directors
 - League officials
- Check each player's equipment periodically to be sure it is properly fitted
- Move location of drills at practice as to not wear out or damage the turf
- Plan and execute a player rotation system during games appropriate for the grade level you are coaching

EDUCATION/KNOWLEDGE/SKILLS:

Must have extensive knowledge of football
Must enjoy working with children of all ages
Must be able to communicate with young players in a positive manner

PERFORMANCE MEASURES:

To carry out the aims and objectives of the Cyclones program as outlined by the club's Board of Directors. To instruct athletes in individual and team fundamentals, strategy, and physical training necessary for them to realize a degree of individual and team success.
